


BOARD OF ELECTIONS

Watchers must be qualified registered electors of the County in which they are authorized to act.

Each political party and body which has nominated candidates shall be entitled to appoint three watchers and each candidate may appoint two watchers, at any general, municipal or special election in each election district in which there are candidates. However, only one Watcher of each party, body and candidate is permitted inside the polling place room during the course of voting. All others must stay at least ten feet from the door of the polling place room along with all other workers.

At the close of the polls, and while the votes are being counted all Watchers are permitted inside the polling place room.

Watchers must carry their Watcher's Certificate at all times and are required to show them upon request.

It is a criminal offense for any person to threaten or drive away any Watcher who is legally entitled to be present inside the polling place room.

Watchers are permitted to keep a list of voters and are entitled to challenge any person applying to vote. The Judge of Elections (or his or her designee), must permit watchers upon their request, to inspect the signed voter certificates or numbered list of voters. This inspection is only permitted during those times when voters are not in the polling place waiting to vote or voting. Watchers are not permitted to make any notations on or alter the voter certificates or numbered list and the inspection of these records must be supervised by the judge of Elections or his or her designee.
